

TREATMENTS FOR ADULT KIDNEY PATIENTS WHO DEVELOP COVID-19



COVID-19 TREATMENTS ARE AVAILABLE FOR THE FOLLOWING GROUPS OF KIDNEY PATIENTS:



ACTION REQUIRED:



To receive treatment you will need to confirm suspected symptoms with a lateral flow test or PCR test and register the result on gov.uk or via 119.

NOTE:


Do this AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE as treatments need to be started early to be effective.

If you have COVID-19, you need to be referred to a specialist service to receive treatment: Covid Medicines Delivery Unit (CMDU) in England; a health professional in Wales or NI; or by phoning your **Health Board in Scotland**.

WHAT TREATMENTS ARE AVAILABLE?

There are two types of treatment, antiviral medicines and monoclonal antibodies. They work in different ways to stop serious illness from Covid-19.

The ones you may be given are:
