








Question 2: *How confident do you feel in...* Explaining the supportive care pathway to patients?








Question 3: *How confident do you feel in...* Identifying patients who should be considered for supportive care?

85.9% feel confident and somewhat confident






Question 4: *How confident do you feel in…* Helping patients to make an informed decision between supportive care and other treatments?













How confident are you in raising the issue of discontinuing dialysis with the patient and family?





Have you completed an Advanced care plan (ACP) with a patient?






53.8% do not feel confident completing an ACP





Have you found an ACP completed by another member of staff helpful in managing a patient?




